## NATIONAL DISASTER MANAGEMENT ACT – REPEAL OF SPECIFIC DIRECTIONS FOR LEVEL 4 OF THE RISK ADJUSTED APPROACH TO RESUMPTION OF ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

The Minister of Trade, Industry and Competition has repealed the specific directions published for Level 4 of the risk adjusted approach to the opening up of economic activity, published on the 12<sup>th</sup> of May 2020 (Government Gazette No. 43308; Government Notice No. R. 524), with immediate effect.

The Minister has acknowledged the important role trade associations such as the RMI have played in establishing business continuity plans and risk adjustment strategies, which are applied in businesses in the automotive aftermarket.

Members are encouraged to continue to apply the provisions of the Business Continuity Plan and Risk Adjustment Strategy recommended by the RMI, and shared with Members on the 30<sup>th</sup> of April 2020.
